## Expected Code of Conduct

Please read with your child and sign. Your signature is an acknowledgment that you both agree to abide by the rules below. The Code of Conduct establishes guidelines for behavior that helps ensure kids of all ages will have fun. Our goal is to create a setting in which everyone feels safe, accepted, and comfortable.

1. We ask that everyone think twice about what they say and how they say things. Inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
2. We ask that everyone be respectful of each other's personal space. Hitting, kicking or any other physically violent behavior will not be tolerated.
3. We are all different and we need to respect those differences. Everyone has his or her own unique gifts. We ask that each member of the cast and production be treated with respect. Mean behavior such as name-calling, teasing, or acting in a way that would hurt anyone's feelings is not tolerated. You may not get along with everyone in the cast but it is important to be friendly and kind.
4. While at the Acton Congregational Church or any other facility, we are considered guests. We have been asked NOT TO TOUCH anything that does not belong to us, not wander the building and to leave the space looking the same as when we arrived. Therefore we ask that everyone participate in clean-up at the end of each rehearsal. Any damage to an item or misuse of any device while on the premises will be taken into matters with your parents and the individuals of that building.
5. We request that you not use cell phones during rehearsals for calls or texting. We understand that there are times a cell phone must be used; please limit all non-emergency use to break time. We will ask that you silence your phone and place it with your belongings during rehearsal time.
